



# THE WELLS HOUSE

## Guest Policies and Guidelines

**To ensure a positive guest experience for all, we ask guests to observe and adhere to some simple guidelines.**

**Bathroom Policy** — use of house bathrooms is limited to the main floor bathroom and the bathroom on the second floor, at the top of the stairs to the left. Please note that the bathrooms are not handicapped accessible.

**Alcohol Policy** - to minimize damage, drinking alcoholic beverages is limited to the following: Wine is allowed inside of The Wells House, however, beer may be consumed only on the outside grounds of The Wells House. Hard alcohol is prohibited both inside and outside of The Wells House. The possession or consumption of alcoholic beverages on the Wenatchee Valley College campus is prohibited.

## To help us preserve The Wells House, the following items and activities are prohibited:

- Stiletto style heels are prohibited inside The Wells House.
- Unaccompanied minors, under the age of 16, are prohibited inside The Wells House and on its grounds.
- Smoking, and the use of illegal drugs is prohibited inside The Wells House, on its grounds, and on the Wenatchee Valley College campus.
- Pets and service animals are prohibited inside The Wells House and on its grounds.
- Moving furniture or artifacts, opening windows or outside doors without the permission of the Wells House Coordinator or Event worker is prohibited.
- Attaching anything to interior or exterior walls, wood trim, ceilings, windows, or doors is prohibited.
- Throwing rice, birdseed, glitter, confetti or lighting fireworks or sparklers inside The Wells House or on its grounds is prohibited.
- Any disorderly conduct is prohibited inside The Wells House or on its grounds, including, but not limited to, running through the home or climbing on any structures.
- Fires and open flame candles are prohibited inside The Wells House and on its grounds.
- The use of stakes for awnings, tents, and other objects are prohibited on the grounds.
- Multiple, large speakers, or excessively loud music is prohibited inside The Wells House or on its grounds.
- Non-State permitted gambling is prohibited inside The Wells House, on its grounds, and on the Wenatchee Valley College campus.
