



BEHAVIOR CONTRACT

The Super Summer Adventure teaching staff strive to provide a happy, safe, spirited summer of learning and enrichment for all ages. To ensure this expectation is honored, all camp participants are required to agree to a behavior contract at the time of enrollment.

This contract emphasizes cooperation and respect for fellow students, teaching staff, the teaching environment, and Museum property.

A parent or guardian will be contacted if a camper engages in:

- Disrespectful, uncooperative, or threatening behavior
- Destructiveness
- Improper physical contact with others

Staff will generate a written report in the event of a second and third incident.

Immediate dismissal from the program can occur at any time depending on the severity of the circumstances.

No refunds will be issued for dismissal from camp as a result of a violation of the behavior contract.
