### COVID-19 Statement

While we currently plan to hold camps during July and August, we will be following the guidelines for events and public health from local, state, and federal officials and we are continually evaluating upcoming events in July and August in light of those guidelines.

### Class changes/Cancellation Policy

The Museum reserves the right to cancel, combine or reschedule classes to adjust for enrollment or unforeseen circumstances. If it is necessary to cancel a class for any reason, registered participants will be informed as soon as possible and extended the opportunity to transfer to another class or receive a full refund.

### Refund Policy

We will refund 75% of the cost of the class up to 2 weeks before the class start. You may also choose transfer to another class provided there is space available in that class. No refunds or transfers will be given within 2 weeks of the class start date.

### Drop-off & Pick-up Procedures

Camps run Monday-Friday, 9 AM - 12 PM and 12:30 - 3:30 PM. Doors will open 15 minutes prior to class time. Classes are held at the Museum except where noted. Wear comfortable clothes and shoes. Please plan to send a lunch with your child if they are attending camp all day. There will be a supervised lunch from 12:00 - 12:30 PM.
