

The Wenatchee Valley Museum & Cultural Center is recruiting volunteer assistants for the 2022 Super Summer Adventures Camps

Super Summer Adventures is a multi-week summer learning and enrichment program. Our goals for the enrichment program is to create an informal, hands-on atmosphere that encourages creative learning and exploration for students entering Kindergarten through 6th grade and to provide our volunteers with a fulfilling sense of purpose, fun, and experience for future work.

This year we will offer five sessions of summer camps:

- Session I: Monday, July 11th – Friday July 15th: Science
- Session II: Monday July 18th – Friday July 22nd: Inventions
- Session III: Monday July 25th – Friday July 29th: Dinosaurs and Fossils
- Session IV: Monday August 1st – Friday August 5th: Rockets and Robots
- Session V: Monday August 8th – Friday August 12th: Artistic Creations

Camps run Monday through Friday from 9 a.m. to 3:30. Our classes are high energy, with lots of hands-on activities. Assistants are an important part of our program. They are an “extra pair of hands” for the instructor. They help gather materials, set up projects, and supervise students. They also help students who are having difficulty or just need a little extra attention. We are accepting applications to be a volunteer for individual weeks, or multiple weeks with a minimum of a one-week commitment.

Minimum Qualifications:

We want energetic, dependable, passionate individuals who are:

- Experience working with children ages 6 to 12 years old preferred
- Experience volunteering or working in child care, school or related field preferred
- The ability to meet state requirements for education and additional center requirements (pass a background check) is required
- Able to work indoors or outdoors and engage in physical activity with children
- **Due to the nature and responsibilities of this role, candidates hired will need to be fully vaccinated for COVID-19 by their first day of work.**
